

Rules and Regulations

1. A hard hat must be worn at all times when mounted BSI Standard hat or above are recommended.
2. The organisers and representative accept no responsibility for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to ponies, horses, owner, riders, spectators, land, vehicle, boxes, trailers, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever.
3. The organisers retain the right to refuse any entry.
4. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or change any class.
5. Any dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
6. Please leave the Livery Yard as you found it.
7. Please do not leave any ponies/horses unattended.
8. Any objections must be made within 30 minutes of the end of the class in question, and a deposit of £20.00 paid which may be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
9. The Judges decision is final.
10. Rider's age taken from 1st January 2010.
11. It is a condition of entry that all competitors have read and agreed to abide by all the rules and conditions.
12. No stallions.
13. Entry fees will not be refunded.
14. Once a competitor has fallen or dismounted in the arena, he/she will be disqualified from the class and must not remount until out of the arena.
15. We advise that all entrants and their horses/ponies are fully insured with Third Party Insurance.
16. Lead rein, children over the age of 3 years.

In Hand Classes 1 - 6

1. Best turned out (pony/horse and handler), handler to be 15 years and under.
2. Best turned out (pony/horse and handler), handler to be 16 years and over
3. Best conditioned breed (any breed), handler any age
4. Mountain and Moorland – small and large breeds, handler any age
5. Best veteran horse, 15 years old and over)
6. Best coloured horse or pony
7. Most appealing pony/horse that the judge would like to take home.

Ring 2 – 10.45am Start

Ridden Classes 8 - 17

8. Best turned out lead rein/first ridden, rider 12 years and under
9. Best turn – open to all

Class 8 & 9 to be judged on appropriate attire, presentation of horse, tack and rider,

10. Style and Appearance, lead rein/first ridden, rider 12 years and under
11. Style and Appearance, open to all

Classes 10 & 11 Style and Appearance are based on turn out, manners of pony/horse, rider's ability and way of going. 50% performance, 50% presentation

12. Ridden Mountain and Moorland – small and large breeds.
13. Pony Club type pony not exceeding 14.3, riders 17 years and under. Including a jump max 75cm
14. Ridden Veteran, 15 years and over
15. Junior equitation, rider 16 years and under
16. Senior equitation, rider 17 years and over

Classes 15 & 16 will involve a jump max 75cm. These classes will be based on rider's ability and use aids, rider's performance and control of the horse, proper attire, rider's position and presentation of horse and tack.

Ring 3 – Working Hunter – Approx start time 1.30pm

17. Lead rein pony not exceeding 14.3hh, rider 13 years and under. Max fence height 35cm.
18. Novice pony not exceeding 15hh. Max fence height 55cm. Not to have won any working hunter classes.
19. Open pony not exceeding 15hh. Max fence height 75cm
20. Novice Horse exceeding 15hh. Max fence height 75 cm.
21. Open Working Hunter, pony or horse. Max fence height 90cm
